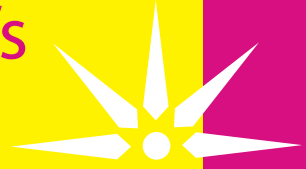

History

The Central Florida Women's League (CFWL) was founded in 1988. Nine women formed a steering committee to meet the needs of women wishing to serve their community. The League was incorporated in 1988 with the original nine serving as the Board of Directors.

These enthusiastic women developed the League's objectives which remain today; to provide its members the opportunity to participate in raising funds for local charities and student scholarships, expand their cultural interests, and participate in social and community activities.

In January, 2001, the League established the Central Florida Women's League Foundation, Inc. (CFWLF) to meet the ever increasing needs of the Central Florida community.

Today, over 120 active members continue the goals set forth in 1988. Each year CFWL members select charities to be the recipients of the League's fund-raising efforts and hands on activities. Additionally, each year college bound students from area high schools have received CFWLF scholarships.



Charity Involvement

The League and its Foundation have raised over \$1,000,000 for dozens of Central Florida charities through its signature fund-raising events including a Wine Tasting Evening, Golf Tournament, and the annual Central Florida Women's League Gala, "Escape to Paradise".



Funds raised are given to the local charities for prioritized needs; for example, a bus for the children at The Coalition for the Homeless, home renovations for the Crisis Nursery, and a new Therapy Kitchen for Health Central Park.

Each charity applicant is thoroughly researched based upon specific criteria.

League members actively participate in the charities' service projects.
